## 2018 Dues are Due

Please pay your dues for 2018, \$25, during the October meeting. If you haven't paid by the end of December then you will not be in the directory. Please see an excerpt from the ByLaws below or contact Melissa Taylor for more information.

### Article V – Dues

A. Dues shall be paid annually and are due in October each year. The calendar year for dues shall be from November 1st through October 31st.

B. Dues shall be twenty five dollars (\$25.00) annually.

C. New members who join between May 1 and October shall pay twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50).

## New Meeting Location

However, the October meeting location has changed. We will start meeting at the fellowship hall at First Presbyterian Church at 3601 Taft Blvd on October 2. This church is the MIDDLE CHURCH across from MSU. Drive in the south entrance on Kirk street.

# 2017 Quilt Show

## Quilting in the Falls

September (21) 22-23

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If you have a quilt entered in the show be sure and attend the September guild meeting. We will discuss the details of when and how to turn in your quilts, when and how to retrieve your quilt after the show, and everything in between. There are some changes from last year, so you won't want to miss it.

Also at the September meeting we will cut, fold, staple, tape, and such to get things ready for the show. I will provide all the cutters, mats, staples, tape, and everything. We just need your participation. **We need hand sewing needles to finish our handouts.**

As discussed in September, we will have **Complimentary Admissions** coupons available for purchase for those who would like to give a coupon to a friend. We will also have **Concession Coupons** available for purchase. Remember, we had to commit to \$500 per day through the concession stand. and we need your support to reach this requirement.

**Yard Signs** will be available at the September meeting. We have twice as many signs this year, so take several and place them in high traffic areas.

### As a reminder (copied from the Rules)

**Quilt Label.** A quilt label is *required* to be sewn to the lower back edge of each quilt with the entrant's name and title of entry.

**Quilt Bags.** All entries *must* be submitted in a cloth bag (*pillowcase*) labeled with the entrant's name and telephone number. Fold your quilt with the label on the outside and place it in the pillowcase with the label on the open side so it can be read without taking the quilt out of the pillowcase.

**Clean and odor free.** Quilts should be clean, free of pet hair, and odor free. Quilts determined to be offensive to the judge or the hanging committee may be disqualified and not hung.

**Deliver** entries in person on **Wednesday, September 20, 2017**, between **10:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. or 4:00 pm - 7:00 pm.** *Entries will not be accepted at any other time or place.* You will receive a receipt, which *must* be presented to pick up your quilt after the show. Deliver entries to: *Jane Benson 4631 Pendleton Dr., Wichita Falls, Texas.*
